

Call for abstracts!

Have you carried out work on the topic of male psychology? Would you like the opportunity to present this to others who are interested in this field? The Male Psychology Conference is taking place on Friday 22nd and Saturday 23rd June 2018 at University College London. There will be prizes awarded for the best rated poster and oral presentations. Abstracts are encouraged from all academic disciplines (including psychology, medicine and sociology etc.) and from undergraduates to consultants and senior academics.

The abstract submission deadline is Mon 30th Jan 2018, 5pm (GMT).

Abstract submission guidelines

Abstracts must be related to a topic related to male psychology, or gender differences

- All abstracts should be in English.
- The abstract title should be brief and specific
- Abstracts for oral presentations and posters must follow the format of: *'Background, Methods, Results, Conclusions'*.
- Author(s) names should be in upper and lower case (e.g. J.J. Smith). The presenting author's name should be indicated.
 - Provide affiliation (University/Institute/Hospital) and City for all authors.
 - Do not include tables or graphs in the abstract.
 - Abstracts to be no more than 300 words in length
 - State whether you prefer your submission to be an oral presentation or a poster
 - Email your abstract to organisingcommittee@malepsychology.org.uk
- Abstracts for workshops must use the headings: *'Who the workshop is aimed at, Background to the topic, Learning Objectives, Teaching Methods, Workshop Leader (short biog)'*.
